## What You Will Do In Week One

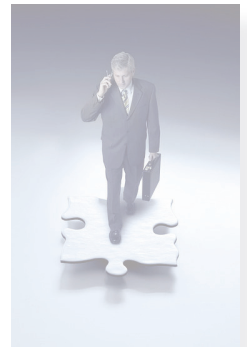

- Identify and analyze key issues affecting the performance of the supply chain

- Develop a vision, mission and values for your supply chain team
